As a resident of Sierra Madre since 1979, I am seeking the office of the Treasurer for the City of Sierra Madre, bringing a wealth of professional and volunteer experience as qualifications.

I am a practicing CPA since 1961, and senior partner in my own firm of Enyedi, Marshall & Montanez, CPAs. Since semi-retirement in 1994, I have devoted substantial volunteer time to our city.

From 1994 through 2001, I volunteered each Monday, pro-bono, to reconcile the City's general fund and payroll bank accounts, becoming thoroughly familiar with the City's finances.

In 1995 I was elected treasurer, and am presently president, of the Sierra Madre Pioneer Cemetery. There, I was instrumental in installing many of the improvements and in increasing its assets from \$242,000 to \$1,050,000 without any liabilities, enabling the cemetery to be self-supporting. Our financial statements have been audited for the past five years and received an "unqualified opinion" each year. In 2002, I passed the California State exam as a "Cemetery Manager," allowing the cemetery to stay in business.

Spearheading in 1998 the rejuvenation of the Sierra Madre Playhouse's interior, exterior, and finances, I helped rescue it from the brink of bankruptcy, culminating in its being voted the "Best Community Theatre" in 2000. I negotiated the purchase of its building and look forward to a "mortgage burning" ceremony in 2010.

I was chosen "Citizen of the Year" in 1999.

As your treasurer I will use my financial background and expertise to apply the highest degree of professionalism, safeguard our resources, oversee expenditures, and guide our City through some of the difficult years that lie ahead.
