PERICLES was originally based on the moral "passion plays" of the Middle Ages. PERICLES retains most of the elements of the passion plays, only the characters and the locations and the timeline are changed.

Most scholars believe that only the second half of the play was penned by Shakespeare himself. It is one of the Bard's hybrid plays, and consequently it is also viewed as one of his problem plays. But at the Knightsbridge, it's sure to be nothing but good times and pirates!
